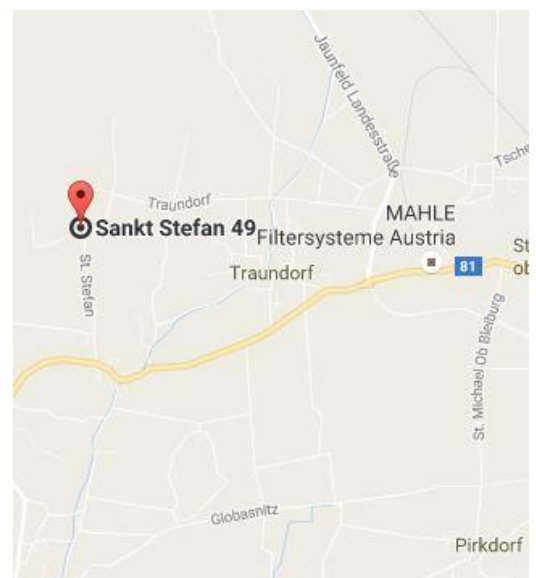
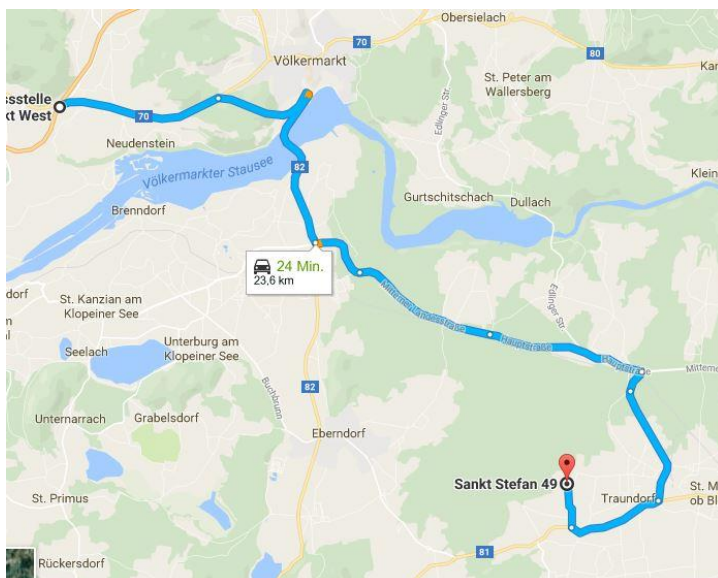
We invite all F3C pilots to join the Austrian World Cup event 2017 in Carinthia!

Field Elevation: Approximately 540 meter above sea level

Number of flights:

Up to 15 registered pilots - We plan to perform 3 "P" flights and 2 "F" flights

Over 15 registered pilots – All pilots perform 3" P" flights with the Top 10 pilots performing 2 "F" flights

Subject to time constraints and number of entrants, there may be the opportunity to fly an additional round of the P Schedule or if additional pilots wish to attempt the F schedule. This can be decided at the pilot's briefing and once we have an accurate weather forecast for the weekend.

Flight Order:

Randomly selected by the computer prior to the start of the competition.

Calibration Flights:

Calibration flight for P Schedule will be selected at random and performed by one of the pilots present during the last World Championship. Calibration flight for F Schedule will be performed by pilot ranked 10th in the preliminary rounds.

Competitors:

This is an FAI F3C World Cup Open event and all F3C pilots are invited to attend.

Competition Rules:

In accordance with the FAI Sporting Code (including ranking), Section 4, 2016 Edition as well as all applicable amendments.

Complaints:

All complaints must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 35€. The deposit will only be returned if the complaint is upheld.

Anti-Doping:

In case a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List for medical treatment then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Awards:

A Diploma will be awarded to all competitors.

Official Language:

Official language will be English.

Entry Fee:

Seniors €80 / Juniors €40

Pilot's registration:

The maximum number of pilots will be 25. Registration will only be confirmed once a registration form and entry fee have been received. Registration will be open from receipt of this bulletin until 1st May 2017. An acknowledgement of your registration will then be sent to you confirming your place is reserved.

Frequency:

2.4GHz only

Electricity for charging:

There is electricity at the flying field for charging your lipo's.
