### F3N World Cup (GBR 2018)

#### Intro:

For the first time ever, an F3N World Cup series of competitions is taking place. We are delighted here in the UK to stage the 2<sup>nd</sup> leg of the series. Utilising the BMFA's National Flying Centre in Buckminster, Lincolnshire, we will be able to combine F3C and F3N (on 2 separate flightlines) for a weekend of heli flying at its best.

This competition will be FAI registered and is supported by the British Model Flying Association (BMFA) and the Association of Helicopter Aerosports (AHA). A separate bulletin is available for F3C.

We invite all current FAI registered F3N pilots to come and compete in this round of the 2018 F3N Euro Heli Series World Cup.

### **Number of flights:**

Maximum 20 pilots. Weather permitting, we will run 4 preliminary rounds (2 x Sets, Freestyle & Music). The top 10 will then go on to fly 1 x Sets, Freestyle & Music.

Randomly selected by computer prior to the start of the competition.

### **Calibration Flight:**

Will be flown at the start of the competition (Sets round). The pilot will be chosen at random.

### **Competitors:**

This is an FAI registered F3N World Cup Open Competition; all current FAI F3N pilots are invited to register. All pilots will need an FAI Sporting Licence.

### **Competition Rules:**

In accordance with the FAI Sporting Code (including ranking), Section 4, 2018 Edition as well as all applicable amendments.

### **Protests:**

All protests must be presented in writing to the Contest Director at the competition site and must be accompanied by a deposit of 35€. The deposit will only be returned if the protest is upheld.

### **Awards:**

Each competitor will be awarded with a certificate. The top three pilots will be awarded trophies.

### **Official Language:**

Official language will be English.

**Entry Fee: €80 Seniors / €40 Juniors** Payment can be made by PayPal to [payments@theaha.co.uk](mailto:payments@theaha.co.uk) UK pilots please contact the organiser for the equivalent £sterling rate prior to paying registration fee.

### **Pilot's Registration:**

The maximum number of pilots will be 20. Registration will only be confirmed once a registration form and entry fee have been received. Registration will be open from 01 January to 13 July 2018.

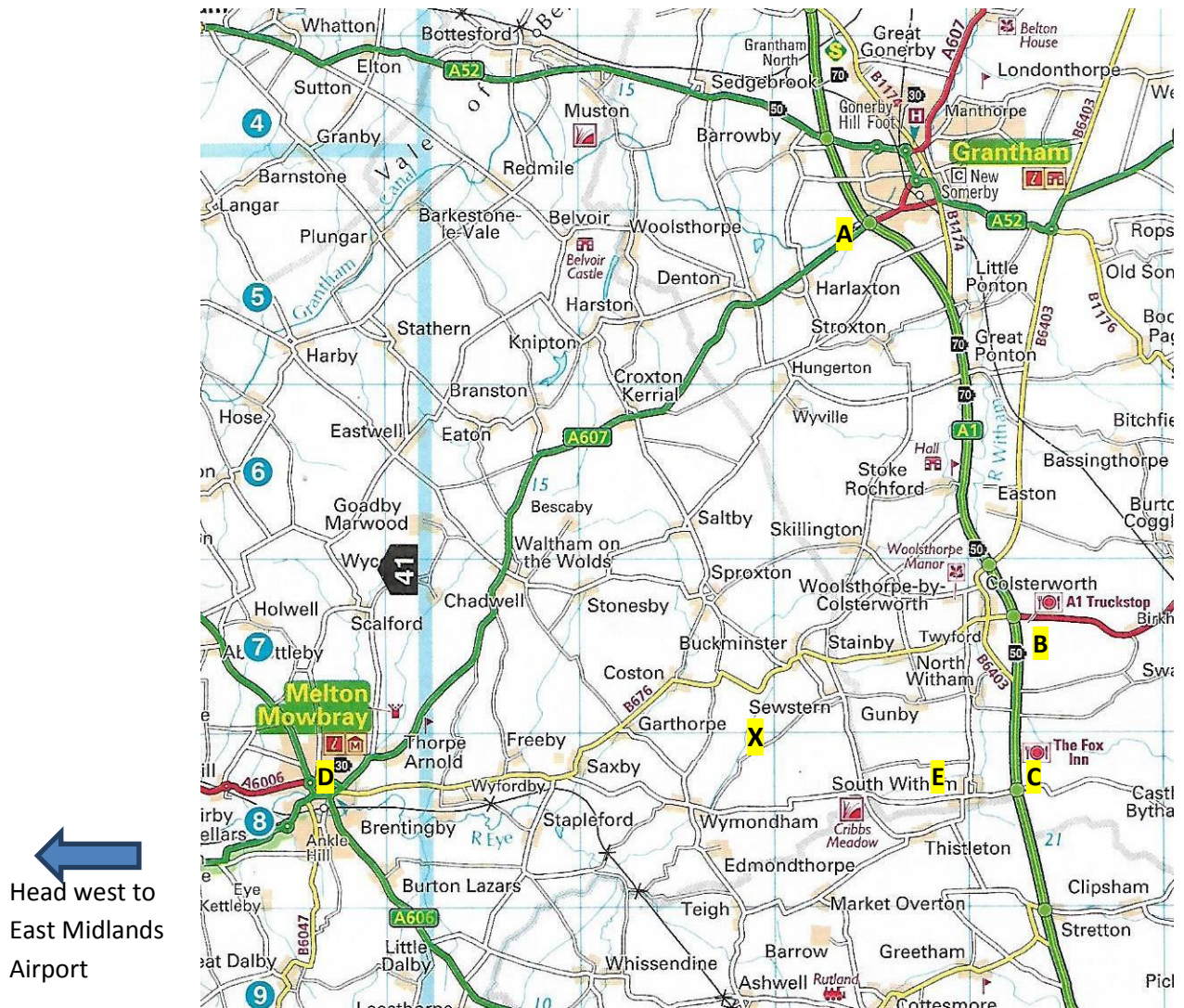
